You should attend a **“Working Together to Safeguard Children Refresher”** course (Introduction) and must do this before attending any experienced course.

Safeguarding Showcases & Conferences are open to everyone. There is no requirement to have completed any courses prior.

Are you a manager, supervising staff involved in safeguarding children?

“Supervision Skills for Managers” (Advanced)

This is the multi-agency training pathway and does not replace internal single-agency safeguarding training. Nor does any single-agency training or the extent of the practitioner’s experience negate the need to follow this pathway.
