New online platform for young people across Kirklees

A new initiative developed by a local VCSE group – **Conscious Youth**, in partnership with Kirklees Council and with Kirklees Youth Alliance (KYA) which provides an excellent online support for young people across Kirklees, including an online virtual youth centre that will host live and recorded sessions, live chat and online activities.

Local young people aged 12-19 will be able to visit Youth Central, a space designed for them to have instant access to a range of activities, support and opportunities at the click of a button.

Sessions such as fitness, beauty, self-care, gaming and arts and craft will run Monday- Friday, hosted by youth workers from across Kirklees. Some sessions will be 'live' over Zoom, giving young people the opportunity to interact 'face-to-face' with youth workers. All activities are designed to be fun and engaging, with young people being instrumental in the development of the platform.

Youth Central will provide information on; careers, training, support services, good news stories, competitions, social action and opportunities after school. The platform is a longer term strategy for youth engagement and is designed to be just as relevant beyond Covid 19, embracing the changing face of youth work.
