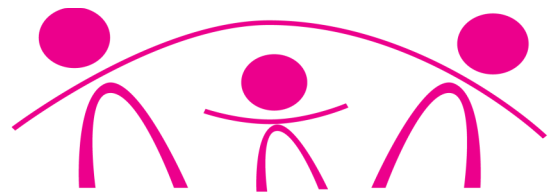

- Conference and Core skills courses

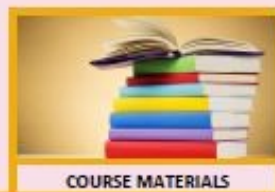
## THE VIRTUAL CLASSROOM
